Warning Signs:

- Excessive visitors
- Loitering on property
- Frequent & unusual traffic patterns
 - * Late at night
 - * Short visits
- Vehicles stopping and resident coming outside to talk
- Excessive packages delivered
 - * USPS
 - * FEDEX
 - * UPS
- Sudden increase in criminal activity in neighborhood
- Hand-to-Hand exchanges
 - * Money
 - * Small items

What To Do:

- Start neighborhood watch
- Log all activity if drug house is suspected
- Speak with property owners about problems with tenants
- NEVER confront the tenant yourself - Report all problems to Kodiak Police Department and Alaska State Troopers
